A valid EFC licence is required.

Referees must be provided based on the total entries per day.

The referees officiating at EFC Circuits should have good national or international level of qualification and be aged minimum 18 and maximum 60.

The referee activity is not paid by the organizer.

In case of not registering each referee by the EFC service portal, a federation must pay 500€ fee for every referee missing per day of competition.

All fencers, teams, coaches and referees must be in possession of EFC licence.
Entering the fencer coach or referee after the deadline is sanctioned by a penalty for a fencer and a coach 50€/person, for a referee 100€ per person.

Format In the first competition of each weapon the initial ranking will be set as follows:
1. Current FIE ranking
2. EFC U23 Circuit ranking + 1000
3. The places of non-ranked fencers are drawn randomly.

Rules & Legal The competition is held on the basis of the rules and regulations of FIE and EFC.

Liability Organizer assume no liability. All participants are responsible for their personal equipment.

Jurisdiction By taking part in the tournament, fencers accept the jurisdiction of the FIE, the EFC and of Swiss Fencing.
